## Gloucestershire Golf Union – County Mens Amateur Championship

Filton Golf Club 23/24 May 2009

Filton Golf Club played host to the County Mens Amateur Championship in its centenary year in glorious sunshine on a golf course prepared to an immaculate standard. The club last hosted the county championship in 1914. There was a strong field with all the players from the Gloucestershire elite squads playing.

The standard was excellent from the start with reports filtering through of several players making birdies early on. This proved true when home club player Ollie Hooper reached the turn in a 5 under par 30. He did not really capitalise on this on the back 9 but still returned a new course record score of 66 to take the morning lead. Mat Stanford, the ex Walker Cup star, now playing at Chipping Sodbury had a great finish to his round to return a solid 67 equalling the previous course record. Andy Rudge, (Bristol & Clifton) just returning from the professional game, also played well to return a solid 68. Nick Scholey (Henbury) & Neil Dean (Minchinhampton) completed the morning tournament scores in the sixties with fine 69s to put themselves in a good position.

With all the county's best players hoping to be selected for the South West Counties Week at Broadstone in 2 weeks time, it was obvious that the second round would be crucial for players to set up a good position to qualify in the top thirty & go into the final 36 holes on Sunday. Michael Day (Henbury) returned a fine 68 to finish on 79/68 – 147, Nick Day also from Henbury put himself in a great position with a calmly produced 69 to go with his morning 74 to return 143. Adam Carson the newly crowned Fairhaven Trophy Champion returned a workmanlike 68



to go with his 72 & return 140.

The best was still to come. Ollie Glaze, (Kendleshire) the current holder of the championship trophy went on a fabulous birdie run to break the course record for the second time in the day with a magnificent 65 to add to his morning 73 & return a 138, the first to break 140 in the day.

The last group of the day still had a surprise when young junior, Chris Lloyd (Kendleshire) celebrated his recent selection to the England Boys team for the World Junior Championships in Japan by equalling the course record of 65 to go with his morning 71 & take the halfway lead.

Local boy Ollie Hooper returned a very good 72 & was in equal second with Glaze on 138 with Mat Stanford also breaking 140 with his 67/42 – 139.

Sunday was an even warmer day with slightly less breeze but this time the pin positions were somewhat more difficult & greens a little faster. This was reflected in the leading scores in the morning with only 2 players beating the par of 70. Leaders Chris Lloyd & Oliver Hooper matched each other with 69s to keep their positions with 205. Ollie Glaze slipped back with a 73 for 211. Andy Rudge returned an excellent round of 70 to record 210 & Adam Carson had a 71 to join Glaze on 211. Tim Clink (Lilley Brook) also returned a good 71 to go to 214.

Going in to the final round there were 6 players within 5 strokes of the leader, Chris Lloyd, who appeared to be slowly taking control of the tournament. He looked in fine form & was still leading by 2 with 9 holes to play. Lloyd made an error on the 12th, taking 6 which gave hope to all the chasing pack but steadied himself to par the 13th & birdie the 14th to regain his composure. He finished in fine style with a fantastic birdie on 17 & closed it out with a par on the 18th.

Lloyd won the championship by a massive 8 strokes & confirmed the promise he has shown since being selected as an EGU representative for the World Boys Championships in Japan in June.

*Ian Watkins, the County Golf Secretary said, 'He has always had the talent to go all the way, he reminds me of Paul Casey when he was a young lad. Strong & stocky, long off the tee with a great touch around the greens and a wonderful attitude to the game: as soon as Chris equalled the course record on Saturday afternoon he knew he was going to win, his confidence went through the roof & he never lost control of the tournament from that moment on. This boy is very, very good & I believe he will be one of Gloucestershire's great professionals in the next 5 years'*
